

PARAMEDIC PROGRAM COMPLETION

In order to successfully complete the program and be cleared for National Registry Testing:

1. Students must meet all requirements for each course as outlined in the course curriculum/syllabi with a grade of "C" or better and must be in good standing with the university and course policies identified in this handbook.
2. Students must pass a written and practical exam at the end of the last semester. (Applications for Paramedic Care, EMTP 256)
3. The practical exam must be passed within two attempts and will be graded based upon criteria set forth by the National Registry of EMT's and/or the Southern University Paramedic Training Program.
4. Failure to pass the final written and practical exam will result in failure of EMTP 256 and students will not be cleared for National Registry Testing.
5. The Medical Director and Program Director will make the final decision for students being cleared for National Registry Testing.
