## PARAMEDIC PROGRAM COMPLETION

In order to successfully complete the program and be cleared for National Registry Testing:

- 1. Students must meet all requirements for each course as outlined in the course curriculum/syllabi with a grade of "C" or better and must be in good standing with the university and course policies identified in this handbook.
- 2. Students must pass a written and practical exam at the end of the last semester. (Applications for Paramedic Care, EMTP 256)
- 3. The practical exam must be passed within two attempts and will be graded based upon criteria set forth by the National Registry of EMT's and/or the Southern University Paramedic Training Program.
- 4. Failure to pass the final written and practical exam will result in failure of EMTP 256 and students will not be cleared for National Registry Testing.
- 5. The Medical Director and Program Director will make the final decision for students being cleared for National Registry Testing.
