PROGRAM NAME: LAMP Undergraduate Scholars Program

Program Description:

The Louisiana Alliance for Minority Participation (LAMP) Program is a mentoring and scholarship program that is

designed to substantially increase the quantity and quality of minority students receiving associate degrees in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines and subsequently to increase the number of minority students entering 4-year universities to earn bachelor degrees in STEM fields. Participation in research (academic year and summer) and completion of the two-semester Job Outlook Seminar Series are some essential conditions for continued support. LAMP

is funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and the Louisiana Board of Regents (BOR).

Program Criteria: Scholarship eligibility criteria include (a) a minimum GPA of 3.0/4.00 (overall and in the major); (b) at least a 20 ACT

composite score or a 1410 SAT (*Critical Reading, Math and Writing*) (950 Old SAT [*Critical Reading and Math*]) composite score (for incoming freshmen); (c) grades in mathematics and sciences courses; (d) intention to pursue full-time (minimum of 12 hours/semester) undergraduate studies at SUSLA leading to a baccalaureate degrees in a science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics (STEM) discipline, not to lead to the practice of medicine; (e) intentions to pursue bachelor degree studies (preferably leading to a graduate degree) in a STEM area (not to include the practice of medicine) after obtaining the associate degree; (f) need, as verified by Financial Aid.. Students are evaluated each semester for

retention and continuation of scholarship status; and (g) United States citizenship.

Program Allowable Costs: Enrollment fees (i.e., tuition, room/board, and fees, etc.).

Funding Duration: Renewable each year, for two (2) years, based on academic performance while pursing undergraduate degree.
